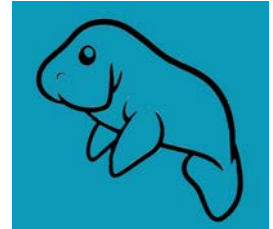

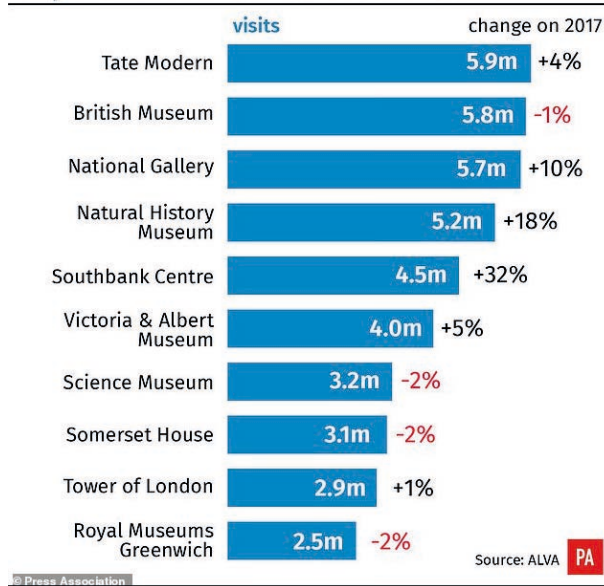
When asked to **explain**, aim to make a point or suggest an idea and then explain what that means or *why* it is a good point, in detail.
