Explain what Pratchett means by "People start out believing in the god and end up believing in the structure."</p>	<p>Give four marks for outlining the following points or similar.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gods are initially worshiped for what they do • Over time, humans interpret the god's wishes. • Humans build a religious structure. • People forget the god and focus on the structure • This may be because gods are uncaring!. <p>Accept any other valid points and development.</p>	4
<p>2. Describe one positive and one negative feature of Lord Vetinari's rulership</p>	<p>Give two marks for each point, if they are developed. One if they are not.</p> <p>Positives - less crime, society is more structured, people are afraid of Vetinari so behave well, less political arguments as one man is in charge, Vetinari is very clever so rules well.</p> <p>Negatives - still a lot of violence, people have no say in who rules them, Vetinari is happy to kill people.</p> <p>Accept any other valid points.</p>	4
<p>3. 'Sam Vimes is the most admirable character on the Discworld.'</p> <p>Do you agree? Explain your answer. Aim to compare Vimes to other characters such as Granny Weatherwax or Vetinari.</p>	<p>For this question, use the following best fit from the table below.</p>	12

Level 1	Describes a view on Vimes. May not compare him to other specific characters. Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar)	1-3
Level 2	Describes their own view and will mention other characters, but maybe not with great detail or accuracy. Fair SPaG – some mistakes. May not be structured very clearly.	4-6
Level 3	Explanations of their own view with clear comparison to other characters. Mentions at least two specific philosophers in some detail. Comes to a clear conclusion. Good SPaG with some errors but a good structure.	7-9
Level 4	Detailed explanations of their opinion in relation to other characters. Reference to philosophical ideas such as stoicism. Mentions at least two specific philosophers in some detail. Comes to a clear, justified conclusion. Excellent SPaG – few errors and good structure.	10-12
