| 1   | Describes a basic opinion about the most impressive labour.<br>May not name any specifically. Does not compare labours.<br><br>Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar) | 1-3                        |
| 2   | Describes their own view on the most impressive labour but may not compare them with much detail.<br><br>Fair SPaG – some mistakes. May not be structured very clearly.                          | 4-6                        |
| 3   | Gives a balanced argument featuring at least three labours.<br>Comes to a clear conclusion.<br><br>Good SPaG with some errors but a good structure.  | 7-9                        |
| 4   | Detailed arguments about the impressive nature of at least three labours.<br>Comes to a clear, justified conclusion.<br><br>Excellent SPaG – few errors and good structure.                      | 10-12                      |
