Level 1	Describes one reason for tourists being attracted. No comparison with other attraction. Reason may be started without much/any development.  Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar)	1-3
Level 2	Describes some attractions to Japan.  <b>OR</b>  Gives a detailed explanation of one attraction.  Comes to a basic conclusion as to what the main attraction is.  Good SPaG – some mistakes but not many.	4-7
Level 3	Complex explanations a range of attractions.  Uses a range of attractions (at least three.)  Comes to a clear, reasoned conclusion.  Excellent SPaG with very few errors.	8-10
