Level 2	Describes their own view and will mention at least one argument for or against modern utility, but these elements may not be connected explicitly. Fair SPaG – some mistakes. May not be structured very clearly.	4-6
Level 3	Explanations of both sides of the argument. Comes to a clear conclusion. Good SPaG with some errors but a good structure.	7-9
Level 4	Detailed explanations of both sides of the argument. Comes to a clear conclusion. Excellent SPaG – few errors and good structure.	10-12
